**Directions:** The SAF Meeting and lunch will take place in the State Nursery Conference Room. We will provide driving directions at the meeting. For those that cannot make the morning session but who wish to attend the field portions From the Nursery in Ames to Holst: head west on Hwy 30 for ~14.5miles, take a right and head north on S. Story St into the heart of Boone. Take a left and head west on Mamie Eisenhower Ave (210<sup>th</sup> st) for ~1mile. Take a right and head north on N. Marion St for ~1/2 mile. Take a left (west) on E26 and follow E26 for 5.8miles. After winding your way around E26 you will take a right and head north on Kale Rd for 0.3miles. On your left will be 168<sup>th</sup> Lane (two grain binds are just to the south of 168<sup>th</sup> Lane.). There will be Forestry Extension field day signs at the last turn. If the weather is bad I would advise car pooling in a 4 wheel drive vehicle as the road is not maintained to its full potential. There will be several vehicles at Holst if you do not have 4 wheel drive capabilities.
