



Emerald Ash Borer Preparation Bark Peeling Workshops Spring 2007

The Pest Management and Environment Program of Iowa State University Extension, the Forestry Bureau of the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, and the State Entomologist's Office of the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship will host a training session to prepare for emerald ash borer. This hands-on workshop will focus on bark peeling techniques, and review the signs, symptoms, and biology of this invasive, exotic insect pest of ash trees.

Arborists, city/county/state forestry staff, landscapers, and related forest personnel are encouraged to attend this free workshop.

The first workshop will be April 11, 2007, at Davenport Public Works, 1200 East 46th Street, Davenport, IA 52807. The second workshop will be April 12, 2007, at the Comisky Park Building, 255 E. 24th St, Dubuque, IA 52001. Two sessions will be offered for each date (see Registration Form).
